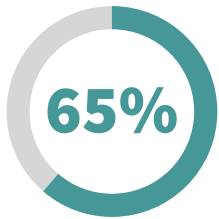

of students experience high or very high stress levels during exams

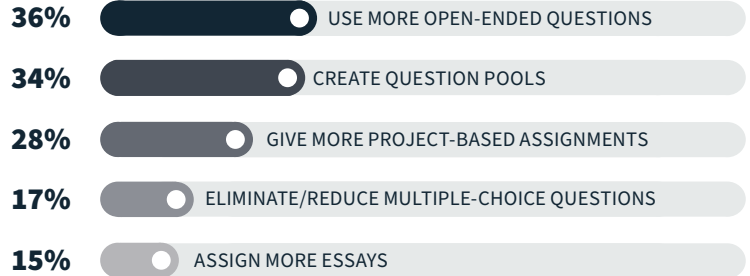


Leading Causes of Academic Dishonesty

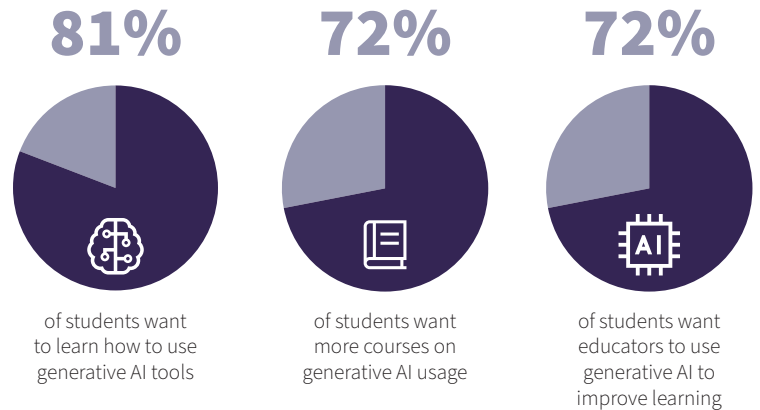

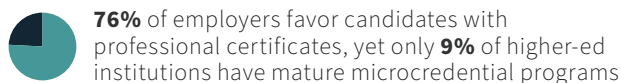
